## BRILLIANT ACTS GIVEN BY SELBY LANE GAKUEN

400 Spectators Witness Outdoor Performances; Prominent Americans and Japanese Express Good Will

Pupils of the Selby Lane Japanese Language School, situated near Redwood City, invited the faculty of the six public schools of Redwood City and Menlo Park and presented an accomplished entertainment and dramas Saturday afternoon, September 4, beginning from 2 o'clock. Like the Grecian performances, the choruses and dramas were presented out of doors in the grounds of the Selby Lane Gakuen. An audience of 400, including forty odd teachers, were in attendance. Miss Kimiko Yamakoshi, talented student of the gakuen, presided over the occasion and delivered speeches in both English and Japanese, outlining the purpose of the affair. The dramas and choruses were exceedingly well presented, and both American and Japanese spectators were impressed.

After the entertainment a social hour was enjoyed, in which tea was served. Those in attendance expressed their admiration for the potential art of the second-generation as revealed by the performances of the day, and much credit for the success is due Miss Yamakoshi for her careful supervision. ## 2 KILLED IN JAPAN VOLCANO ERUPTION

Two lives were lost when Mt. Tokachi, on the island of Hokkaido, northern Japan, erupted lava Thursday, September 9. Clouds of sulphurous smoke rolled down the mountain side. Villagers, panic stricken, fled for safety.

Tokachi, a mountain of sulphur, erupted, May 24, last year, causing approximately 150 deaths and injuring more than 200. The property loss was about \$70,000.

A lake in the crater, released by the eruption, poured down the mountain sides, inundating several villages. Rice fields and houses were buried in mud and lava, and 1000 persons were made homeless.
