JAPANESE TO CONDUCT NIPPON GAKUEN AT FRENCH CAMP

For some time the proposal to erect a Japanese language school at French Camp, near Stockton, has been discussed, but the Japanese of the locality have finally decided to purchase a dance hall building, which is available in the vicinity of the Japanese community and convert it into a language school.

Japanese at French Camp number 32 or 33 families, scattered within two miles of the dance hall in question, and children of grammar school age number 41, while there are 20 odd children of the kindergarten age.

The building and three lots will be purchased at the current price of \$2,400, and a corporation for the purpose of acquiring the land is now being made by American-born citizens of the locality.

JAPANESE CITIZENS OF HAWAII URGED TO VOTE

Assimilation of Orientals Is Object of Movement

The young men and women of Japanese or Chinese descent, who were born in Hawaii and thus automatically are citizens of the United States, should be encouraged to perform the civic duties of all citizens.

Territorial government officials, leaders of civic organizations and the central committees of the major parties approve the movement, which is regarded there as merely a part of the general program of assimilation of persons of Oriental descent.

5000 Voters Will Register

It is estimated that about 5000 voters of Japanese ancestry in the territory will register. The proportion, of course, will increase rapidly as the young people of Japanese ancestry attain their majority in larger numbers.

There are probably 8000 or more Chinese thus qualified. The total registration in 1924 was 37,000. Secretary Brown of Hawaii says that with the increased stimulus furnished by the movements among the racial groups, it is hoped this year to bring the total to 45,000.

Hanako and Shunzo Kajiwara Returns From Japan; Give Impressions

Hanako, Shunzo Kajiwara returned Stockton safely after a 43-day sojourn in Japan. The brother and sister (both 15 years old) are in the same class in grammar school, and they utilized the summer vacation by visiting the home of their parents.

- Q.—What were the things you disliked most of all while in Japan? A.—We disliked to sit on the tatami, and the narrow roads disturbed us. Q.—What did you like most? A.—The deliciousness of Japanese beef and vegetables. Q.—And your friends in Japan? A.—We like Japanese boy and girl friends immensely, even better than American friends. Q.—And Japanese weather? A.—We were tormented by the extreme heat. Q.—Enjoy the trip on train? A.—Japanese train is very narrow compared with those in America. But the second-class compartments are very clean, and we really liked the "obento" (lunch) on the train. Q.—Is it easier to make a living in Japan?
