## Japan To Build Tunnel Under Shimonoseki Straits, 2 Miles

Work on a railway tunnel connecting the main island of Japan with the Southern island, Kyushu, is to be begun next year.

The tunnel, which is to cost 2,000,000 yen, will pass beneath the Straits of Shimonoseki. Together with its approaches the new section of railway will be about seven miles long from Moji to Shimonoseki, though the actual under-sea tunnel will be little more than two miles long.

6 New Students Enroll at Mountain View High

Six new Japanese students enrolled at the Mountain View High School. They are Takeshi Hori, Masao Oku, Kiyoshi Ishikawa, George Tanaka, Tonai, and Takao Yamashita.

The four students in the sophomore year are Frances Funabiki, Tayeko Kiyomura, and Gozo Kawamoto. Juniors are Roy Tsuruda, and Taro Kawamoto. Seniors, Tomoyoshi Abe and Henry Kiyomura. Henry is a star on both the high school football and basketball squads.

Another shock was accomplished, Thursday, September 16, when Jean Borotra, the colorful "Bounding Basque" and holder of the Wimbledon championship, eliminated William M. Johnston, the veteran Californian, who has been the champion's foremost rival and his partner in Davis Cup triumphs over seven straight seasons, in a five set struggle of 3-6, 6-3, 6-4, 6-4.

Altogether, it was as dark and gloomy a day as American tennis has ever known, for Rene Lacoste, third of the major French threats, overcame the United States Davis cup captain, Richard Norris Williams, in straight sets, 6-0, 6-3, 6-4.

Vincent Richards, youngest of America's "big four," was the only one of the quartet to escape defeat in the French onslaught and now stands out as Uncle Sam's sole hope of keeping the national tennis title on home shores.

He proved himself at the top of his game for the fight against the French invasion by the convincing manner in which he disposed Jaques Brugnon, 6-2, 6-1, 6-2.

Japan Beats Hawaii In Tract Meet, Osaka

Japan defeated Hawaii in an international track meet in Osaka, September 12. The Hawaiian relay race team ran the 400 meters in 41.25 seconds, within 2.5 of a second of the world record set in 1924 by an American team running in France.
