TO-DAY'S TOPICS

President and the Navy

The House Naval Committee of the sixty-ninth Congress is at odds with the President on the naval budget. The President's allowance of \$574,000,000 for national defense, exclusive of non-military items, is evidently not satisfactory to the committee in view of the "alarming" state of our naval inadequacy discovered by the committee through the aid of naval experts. Wherefore, Chairman Thomas S. Butler of the committee is sent to interview the President "to ascertain if President Coolidge was accurately informed on the condition of the Navy when he refused to increase the budget and when he failed to provide for the three remaining light cruisers already authorized by Congress."

A glance at the President's budget message to Congress should make such an inquiry unnecessary. He decreased the naval appropriation because "no threatening cloud at the present time darkens the sky. Our intent and attitude is one of friendly regard toward all nations and peoples."

As to the construction of the three of the eight light cruisers authorized by earlier law, the President declared with an admirable spirit of international regard: "This country is now engaged in negotiations to broaden our existing treaties with the great powers which deal in the elimination of naval arm-

aments. I feel that it would be unfortunate at this time and not in keeping with our attitude toward these negotiations to commence the construction of these cruisers."

The fact is that President Coolidge is fully informed as to the exact status of our Navy, and he also knows that his appropriation of \$313,815,500 for the Navy alone "is a very considerable sum to spend for protection in time of peace." And those who deplore the state of our national defense should look to the President's recommendation for \$82,500,000 for the first year's building of the army and navy air forces and for furtherance of Secretary Hoover's plans to encourage commercial aviation. The air force will be the main spring of any war in the future. President Coolidge is fully aware of this fact and his budget provides funds where they are needed without unnecessarily embarrassing movements for further international limitation of naval armaments.

EMPEROR'S CONDITION IS CRITICAL; CABINET IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION

Cabinet and Privy Council Assemble in Extraordinary Session at Hayama

Social to The Japanese American News Tokyo, Dec. 16 (Received in S. F. 2 a. m.)—Extraordinary Cabinet meeting was called at Hayama near the Imperial Villa where the Emperor of Japan is stricken with pneumonia complications and is in a critical condition. The entire Cabinet and Privy Council, together with all the higher officials of the Ministry of the Imperial Household, were in attendance at the meeting.

The condition of the Emperor became worse to-day, and his pulse became so weak that it nearly ceased beating temporarily. It is reported that death is regarded as a matter of time.

Tokyo, Dec. 16 (Received in S. F. 7 a. m.)—The Emperor's pulse stopped beating temporarily, but was revived by medical injection.
