Borah Hostile to American Intervention in Nicaragua

The trouble that is brewing in Nicaragua is becoming daily more acute. The latest development in this Nicaraguan affair is the dispatch from Washington intimating that Senator William E. Borah (Republican), chairman of the Senate Foreign Affairs Committee...

The unjustified military gestures of the State Department in countenancing armed intervention and naval patrol of the coast of Nicaragua should be curbed. We have no moral right to interfere directly or indirectly in the internal politics of Nicaragua.

The whole trouble with Nicaragua is that its government, in common with the governments of other Central American countries, is patterned after the old Spanish vice-regal regimes; that is, in spirit, colonial fiefs, ruled by bitterly contentious semi-Creole families.

The report came after the Prince had retired, and it was brought to him by Baron Hayashi and Count Mayeda, both of whom are accompanying him on his hurried trip to homeland.

The news of the death of the Japanese Emperor was first announced to the general passengers on board the ship when the paymaster gave the report at the Christmas morning service while the orchestra played music of grief. Out of respect to the Prince over his great loss representative passengers decided to cancel the usual Christmas party.

JAPANESE LOSE TILT TO CHINESE BY SAFETY

Yoke Choy Scores Winning Two Points During Last 2 Minutes

Held back by penalties and fumbles, the Japanese football team was defeated by the Yoke Choy Club at Ewing Field, San Francisco, Sunday afternoon, December 26, by the score of 15 to 13. The winning points were made on a safety in the last two minutes of play when a Japanese player was thrown over his own goal line by two Chinese boys.

The bleachers were filled with a big crowd of Japanese fans, and the Japanese girls put a lot of feeling in their yells and outyelled their rivals. The Japanese players wore jerseys and had mourning bands on their sleeves because of the Emperor's death. The Chinese wore blue jerseys and all new equipment. The Japanese were bare legged. In stature the Japanese were midgets compared to the giants of the Chinese squad.

In the first quarter it looked like an easy victory for the Japanese team when they scored their second touchdown soon after the first one; but the Chinese came back strongly, scoring one in the first quarter, adding another touchdown in the second quarter, and winning the game with a safety in the fourth period.
