EDITORIAL Senate Should Approve Dirigible Construction

The Senate should approve and the President sign the bill passed by the House of Representatives appropriating \$200,000 to begin construction on the two giant dirigibles authorized in 1926. Procrastination and apathy in this matter will find us relegated to the rear in aerial competition of the future which will be of no less national significance to the Nation as the merchant marine of the past and present.

International and intercontinental commerce of the future will be accomplished through air-planes. Giant dirigibles and air-planes will replace ships on the seas as freight and passenger carriers, and this will be accomplished within ten years.

The great impetus given the construction of dirigibles by Powers will have beneficial results in commercial navigation. Spain has already ordered from Germany a Zeppelin to be launched in autumn for a regular monthly trans-Atlantic route from Seville, Spain, to Buenos Aires, Argentina. It will make the distance of 6,250 miles in from three and a half to four and
