High School Orator Is Honored Again

John Aiso, brilliant second-generation orator of Hollywood, who has gone for a visit to Japan following his graduation from the Hollywood High School, is being tendered with warm reception by the Japanese people. Mr. Aiso, it will be remembered, was the valedictorian of his graduating class. He also won first place in one of the preliminary events of the national oratorical high school contest, over his American fellow student who later won the national honor.

Word now comes from Japan that John Aiso is being greeted with much enthusiasm in the academic circles, and he was recently presented before the English Club of the Waseda University and was asked to be one of the judges of a "model English oratorical contest" conducted there.

Mr. Aiso is one of the finest representatives of the second-generation Japanese-American on the Coast. He is a true American and a patriot. His glowing words on the American flag and the Constitution could not be more eloquent, as one Los Ange-

les paper declared in an editorial, "had his forefathers arrived in the Mayflower." For true Americanism is not dependent upon race, color, or creed. It is the man that makes an American, not the race to which he belongs. And Mr. Aiso himself is an eloquent rebuttal to the befuddled reasoning of some anti-Japanese agitators who insist that the Japanese-American cannot be "Americanized."
