## JAPAN TO ACCEPT INVITATION TO 3-POWER TREATY

Foreign Minister Shidehara To Cable Instructions To Matsudaira Today

Tokyo, March 11—The Japanese Cabinet Council, which has been considering President Coolidge's proposal for three-power naval conference, has unanimously decided to accept the invitation. The Foreign Minister, Baron Shidehara, called at the Imperial Palace to report results of the meeting to His Majesty and ask for his approval. Baron Shidehara will cable instructions today to Ambassador Matsudaira at Washington to tender verbal acceptance to the American Government. It is also indicated here that Japan will express regret over the French and Italian non-participation and will give assurance of Japan's willingness to cooperate in the interest of international peace.

China has a history dating back to 200 B.C.

It possesses a population of four hundred million people.

The present factional war in China is the struggle for supremacy between the forces of the Kuomintang or the Nationalists, commonly referred to as the Cantonese, and the northern war lords, Chang Tso-lin and Wu Pei-fu.

Chinese writers claim that though the South and the North battle for supremacy, they are both imbued with the same ideal—namely, "the abolition of all semblance of foreign control."

The Kuomintang armies now control 55 per cent of the population of China. The basic principles of the Kuomintang are, according to Henry W. Harris, in the Boston Globe:

"1. People's Nationalism—The freeing of China from foreigners who have tied up the country by

treasures dictated at the cannon-point.

"2. People's Sovereignty—Development of education and political democracy."

"3. People's Livelihood—Better opportunities for Chinese business men; better conditions for Chinese labor."

At present war clouds are looming over Shanghai, where a decisive engagement is expected to take place. Troops are being rushed to the Shanghai fighting fronts. Only the future can tell what the outcome will be.
