**Seven Rules for Fighting Cancer**

Dr. Joseph Bloodgood, noted cancer specialist of the John Hopkins University, Baltimore, has given the following seven rules to fight the spread of cancer:

"Don't trifle with your skin. If you have a wart, mole, sore or itchy area go to a physician. He will decide whether you are in danger of cancer."

"Pay attention to oral hygiene. Children know oral hygiene, but parents do not. Fully 75 per cent of physicians and dentists don't care for their teeth properly. A white patch or a sore often precede cancer."

"Don't neglect lumps on the breast. That goes for men and boys and girls as well as for women. See a doctor."

"And watch your stomach aches. Children today know the relationship between a stomach ache and appendicitis. If we could teach adults as much about the relationship between a stomach ache and cancer we could almost wipe the disease from the earth."

"If you have a pain or swelling about a joint see a physician"

**Japan Maps Plan for Egg And Frog Production**

Government To Spend 3 Million Dollars To Popularize Frogs

Tokyo Dispatch—Japan will spend the sum of \$3,000,000 in the next ten years in order to teach her people to eat frogs and to produce and eat eggs and chickens.

**JAPAN IS GREAT IMPORTER OF EGGS:**

Statistics show that at present Japan imports \$9,000,000 worth of eggs a year and it is indicated that this sum will be trebled within ten years if the demand continues to increase at the present rate. In order to meet the demand at home by increasing the domestic output the government has established experimental stations in the rural sections in order to give the farmers the benefits of the best stocks of chickens suitable for each locality.

**JAPAN ATTEMPTS TO POPULARIZE FROGS:**

It is that the Japanese government has been trying for ten years to popularize frog legs but has met with considerable difficulty due largely to the fact that the supply of insects upon which frogs live is insufficient.

**EXPERTS SOLVE FROG FOOD PROBLEM:**

Experts, however, have discovered that frogs can live on the pupae of insects, if this diet is provided them in the tadpole stage, and it is believed that this discovery will solve the problem.
