The grand membership drive contest of the Sacramento Japanese Students' Club, which was begun a few days ago at the regular May meeting, is now in full swing.

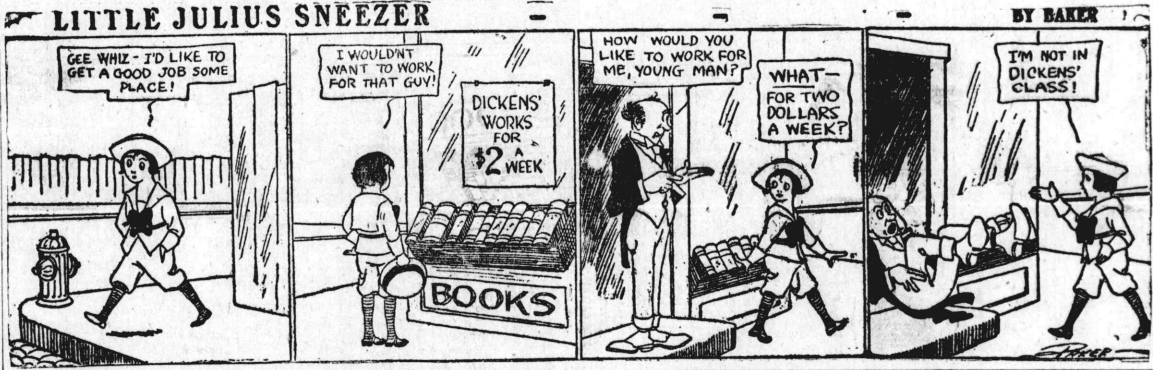
