EXCHANGE OFFERING OF NEW TREASURY BONDS Notice is given of a new offering of UNITED STATES TREASURY BONDS, dated June 15, 1927, and bearing interest from that date at the rate of 3% per cent. The bonds will mature in twenty years, but may be called for redemption after sixteen years. Second Liberty Loan bonds will be accepted in exchange for par. Accrued interest on the Second Liberty bonds offered for exchange will be paid as of June 15, 1927. 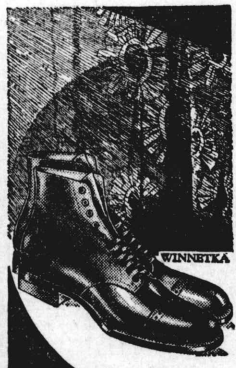

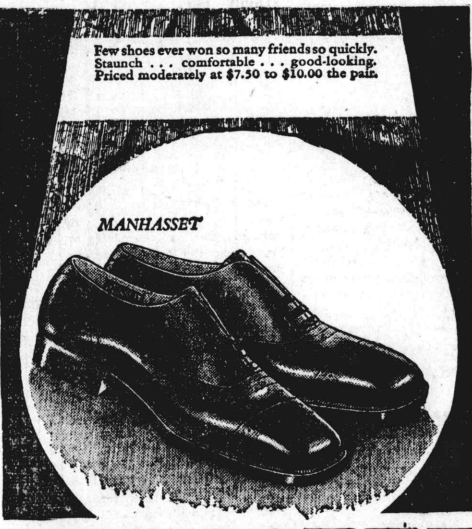

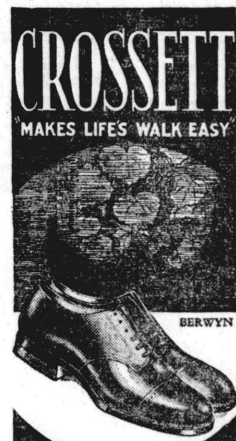
