(Continued from yesterday) 3. The lower the species, the less conscious and more instinctive these "gropings" are. Even among the lowest forms we find traces of physical progression in the same direction as man, and the monkey has progressed far on the same lines, but these similarities are the result of similar demands in physical environment and do not necessarily imply relationship.

DEVELOPING OF SPECIES MEANS FREEDOM

4. The development of the higher species means the winning of freedom, mobility, and adaptability; and finally, in case of man, the ability to shape the future by rational control, which points toward the emancipation and full realization of life. Here, we find the most compelling reason for our faith in the "immortality of life."

5. Any persistent activity of existence warrants us in affirming a correlative in environment. Activity cannot exist in a state which is isolated and independent of environment. Our life, whether of body or mind, is vitally concerned with some kind of environment. But to an even greater extent than we can create our bodily environment, we can create the environment of our minds, and raise it from the material to spiritual plane.

1. The "will" or "purpose to live" can never be accounted for by evolution itself; it is not to be derived by any possible means from the "natural selection" of a "favorable variation"; for the will to live and this will toward the full emancipation of life is an undeniable fact which our life experiences directly; it is a fact which exists before reflective thinking can begin.

2. We really experience our spiritual life and its development or degeneration. Our religious activity shows this aspect of our existence; we feel that we have a right to believe in the reality of our spiritual environment.

3. Evolution is not a progress in matter. Matter cannot progress. It is a progress in "life"—in the case of man, progress in what we call "spirit." Evolutionary movement, in other




