Senator Wheeler on China

Senator Burton K. Wheeler, in his speech before the International Trade Club the other day, propounded some shrewd observations on China which deserve more than passing note. The Western countries have treated China badly, but all their material concessions wrenched from this sleeping dragon of the Orient could not have produced the present ferment to such a high pitch of anti-foreign antagonism were they not accompanied by extremely bad behavior. For the Chinese, who are the most irrational among the characteristically sentimental races of the Orient, place greater stress upon etiquette than any other people on earth. To them "saving the face" is more important than material considerations involved. And everywhere, especially in America and even in China itself, the Chinese has never been able to "save that face". In the foreign section of Shanghai for instance, the Chinese, who outnumber the foreigners and pay major portion of the taxes, are not permitted to dine with a white man, and were he the richest man in the Orient, a Chinaman is not allowed in the hotels there. Now if you not only carry this humiliating discrimination on an international scale, but inflict material infringement by taking concessions from his country, you have the reasons for which that nation is revolting.

Fortunately, the foreign powers in China have come to realize their blunder. They are now competing with one another not to grab more territories but to restore those that have already been in possession. They see that this is the most rational course to take not only in the interest of China but also for their own country's commerce. For a revolting China reflects her rage in the jerk of the string that controls the purse of foreign capitalists. China's protestations are no longer in vain;

CONFERENCE AT DAIREN AGREES ON POLICY IN MANCHURIA, MONGOLIA

Foreign Office, Manchurian Company To Exercise Joint Control

TOKYO, August 18—The Dairen Conference which is now being conducted by K. Yoshizawa, Minister to Peking; Vice-Foreign Minister Mori; and representatives of the South Manchurian Railway Company will draw distinction between the problems of China proper and those of Mongolia and Manchuria. The latter will be controlled jointly by the Foreign Office with the South Manchurian line.

It is indicated that the Foreign Office will protect Japanese commercial interests already established in China by cooperating with the army organizations.

Prince Starts Out For Japanese Alps


