TIMELY TALK GIVEN ON SUNDAY BEFORE BERKELEY FELLOWSHIP

Members Hear Mr. Follet on "Situation of Church in China"

BERKELEY—"Through fire and persecution, the Christian Church in China is finding a new soul and creating splendid future leaders of China."

Such was the gist of the talk given before the members of the Fellowship last Sunday night at Dwight Way Christian Church by Mr. Follet, an evangelistic worker, who had recently returned from his post in Wu-Fu, near Nanking, for a brief furlough.

"In China," he expressed further, "Christianity is regarded as a special religion of the foreigners, and since one of the underlying motives of the present turmoil is the desire to drive out all foreign influences, the followers of Christ, even among the Chinese, are constantly harassed and imposed upon in many ways."

"An example of injustice is the fact that whenever a Chinese force occupies a town, the troops are inevitably first quartered in the Christian churches and then the temples of other religions."

"The Southern army, especially, was guilty of unjustifiable atrocities such as the cold-blooded killing of Dr. Williams, president of Nanking College, who was held up by one of the plundering mercenaries. When asked to surrender his watch, Dr. Williams did not resist, but held the watch out with a joking remark in Chinese, 'You don't really want this watch, do you? It belonged to my mother.' But the question enraged the soldier and answered with a rifle-shot thru Dr. Williams' head."

"The news of his death ran like wildfire through Nanking, and the Chinese of this city who had, heretofore, favored the Southern cause, immediately shifted their sympathy to protect the American and other foreign missionaries. The Southern soldiers hunted all that day for the foreigners but they were not to be found as the Nanking Chinese stubbornly refused to disclose their whereabouts. The martyrdom of Dr. Williams had not been in vain."

Following Mr. Follet's talk, an announcement was made concerning a Fellowship "supper" to be held this coming Sunday at Dwight Way Christian Church at 6 p.m. All young people are invited to come and enjoy the "eat."
