JAPANESE AMBASSADOR TO PARIS REACHES KOBE FROM NAVAL CONFERENCE

Viscount Ishii Expected To Arrive in Tokyo Today

Special to the Japanese American News TOKYO, October 10—Viscount K. Ishii, Japanese ambassador to Paris, arrived at Kobe this morning, and is expected here tomorrow.

Viscount Ishii was one of the chief delegates to the recent Arms Limitation Conference in Geneva. He has represented Japan at most of the important parleys at the League of Nations, and to a great extent has determined Japan's policy in European affairs.

But that was not Japan's goal. She needed better players. Rather, therefore, than develop a string of men who might make a fairly good showing but nothing damaging, Nippon has selected youngsters with possibilities of attaining a greater

FELLOWSHIP OF BERKELEY HEARS STIMULATING TALK BY STITT WILSON SUNDAY

Members Are Also Treated To Social by Dr. Hunter

BERKELEY—The world is like a great mother, endeavoring to heal the scars of strife among her children nations, and in her heart, she must be sobbing to see her giant son—the United States—standing apart in silence and scorn at the League of Nations and World Court. But world is patient and some day America will realize that to accept the responsibilities of international justice requires fearless sympathy—courage in peace more sublime than heroism in war.

Such was the dominant theme of a magnificent address given by Honorable Stitt Wilson, at the First Congregational Church of this city, which was heard by many members of the local Fellowship on Sunday night.

"Impressions of Present-Day Conditions in Europe", was Mr. Wilson's topic, and he related many interesting experiences of his sojourn in London, Paris, Berlin, Geneva and Vienna, especially striking was his statement that before the World War Vienna had been one of the most unsanitary capitals of Europe, but following the collapse of the Austria-Hungary Empire, the Social-Democrats, having come into power, had made such remarkable improvements that the poorest people could live in the finest apartments for \$5 per month, and no one was allowed to throw a bit of waste or paper in the streets without being fined. As a consequence, Vienna is now one of the cleanest and most beautiful cities on the Continent.

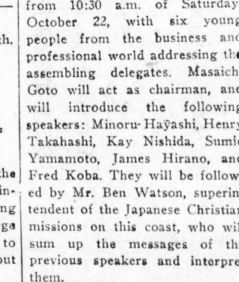
FIRST JAPANESE GIRL IS ELECTED MEMBER OF U. C. PHI BETA KAPPA

Marian Nambu of This City To Be Initiated October 27

Meeting the highest test of scholarship and character at the University of California, Miss Marian Nambu of this city has just been elected member of the Phi Beta Kappa, which is the highest university honor society. She is the first Japanese girl to be accorded this honor at the university, and the initiation will take place on Thursday evening, October 27, from 6:15 o'clock, in the Memorial room of the Stephens Union, University of California. A formal reception will be held immediately following the initiation.

Miss Nambu, who resides at 614 Pine street, is the eldest daughter of the proprietor of the Nambu Hotel. She has made a brilliant scholarship record at the university, having graduated from her political science course six months before the regular schedule. She is already a member of the Phi Sigma Alpha, the national political science honor society among university students. Her present election to the Phi Beta Kappa marks her as the third Japanese to be so honored, the others being Naoshige Tamagawa and Hajime Ueyama. Miss Nambu, it will be recalled, is a one-time winner of the Northern California High School oratorical contest sponsored annually by the Japanese Alumni Association of the University of California. She expects presently to resume her studies at the university by taking post-graduate course in political science for her Master's Degree.
