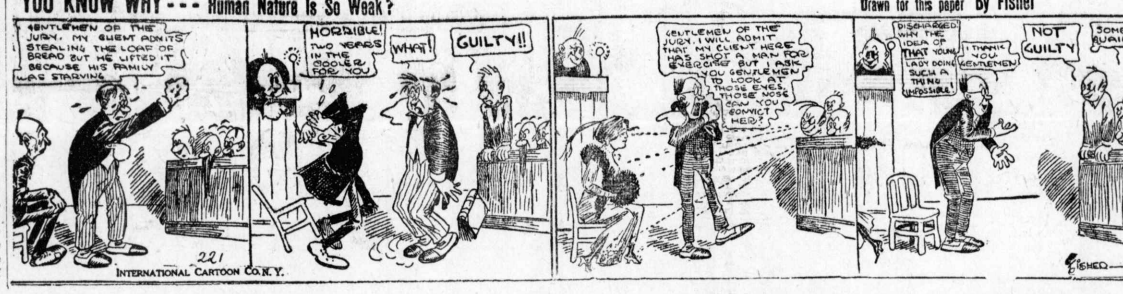
The Japanese All-Star team en-
