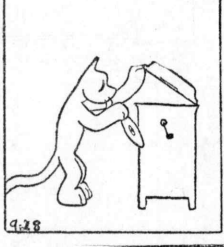
Screen Pre-View "CHICAGO"

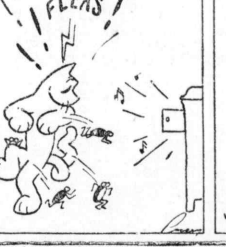

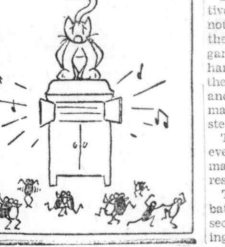
