LOSS OF PRINCESS MOURNED

Special to the Japanese American News TOKYO, March 8—Funeral services for the late Princess Hisa Sachiko, youngest daughter of the Emperor and Empress who died early this morning, will be held at 10 o'clock today at the Imperial Household Department today.

Million People Migrate To Northern China

DAIREN, Manchuria, March 8 (U.P.)—Approximately 1,000,000 Chinese left war torn sections of that country in 1927 to emigrate into Manchuria, where peace is guaranteed by the Japanese government, it has been announced here, and estimates place the likely figure for this year at from two to four million.

Shantung, as well as other Chinese provinces, has contributed its quota of emigrants, as banditry and depredations of robber bands has increased in that section which was restored to Chinese sovereignty by terms of the Washington Conference treaties.

The events narrated in the drama of the forty-seven Ronin date back to the beginning of the eighteenth century, when Japan was under feudalism and the Mikado, as the Emperor was then styled, lived in seclusion in his capital at Kyoto while the real rule was carried on by a military dictator known as the Shogun, who made his headquarters in Tokyo, then called Yedo. The Mikado never left the precincts of his palace, and when he had any orders or messages to convey to the Shogun he did so by means of an ambassador.

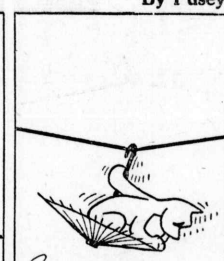
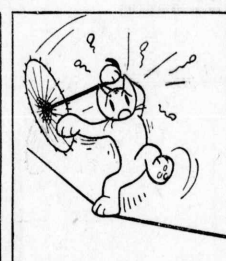
