Filipino Boy Dies in Saving American Girl

SHANGHAI, March 29—(United Press)—A tale of staunch heroism recently came from a street in the International Settlement where Japanese, Filipinos and American boys play baseball.

Pedro Diaz, 11-year-old Filipino, was at bat. A ball thrown by Young Toto, a 10-year-old Japanese pitcher, came toward him. Pedro swung and connected. The ball sped to the distant outfield. The boy rounded first, second, and headed for third.

But at that moment a motor car, driven by a Chinese, turned up the street. At the same time Dorothy Jane Morgan, three, the daughter of an American resident, wandered out on the diamond.

Pedro forgot the ball game and dashed for the little girl. He was able to push her out of the way just as the automobile, its brakes screeching, slowed its pace.

The boy was hit. He was taken at once to the General Hospital, but the best medical aid that could be engaged was powerless. He died on the operating table.

JAPANESE HITS OIL DEPOSIT

San Juan Man Here In Behalf of Project

Something like the blessing of Aladdin's magical lamp seemed to have affected the fortune of a Japanese, Jonosuke Moriyasu of San Juan, who struck a rich oil vein in his land at the level of 900 feet below the surface.

After having struggled for many years in raising funds to buy the well, he at last was rewarded for his efforts with what is believed to be a very promising find. Elated beyond words by this glad tidings, he arrived in this city and visited the various local prominent Japanese financiers in order to raise funds for beginning the extraction work.

"If possible," he is said to have declared, "I would like to raise the necessary funds among the Japanese." 
A program of motion pictures, songs and various musical numbers is to be given. Walnut Grove will supply one of the features on the entertainment.


Omoto To Trum Over KGO Tonight


