HEAVY FIGHTING PREDICTED FOR CHINA AS GENERAL PAI MARCHES TOWARD HANKOW

Chiang Calls Forces To Combat Revolt

FENG UNABLE TO CO-OPERATE

FIGHTING IS EXPECTED NEAR HANKOW MIDDLE OF MARCH FOR CHINA SUPREMACY

SHANGHAI, Mar. 4.—(Special)—After eight months' of peaceful reign, Southern China is again about to enter into a period of heavy fighting with the life of the newly founded Nationalist government on the verge of disruption.

Torn by political dissensions from within its organization and with the left ranks of the communists increasingly menacing the moderate faction now in control, the new republic faces a gloomy prospect indeed as the warm season approaches and the fighting season is about to begin.

HSI ADVANCING NORTH

General Hsi Chung Hsi, powerful warlord of the Kwangsi district, is now steadily advancing his formidable army northward to execute Nanking, the capital of the Nationalist government, and threatens to execute another one of these frequent Chinese coup d'etat.

General Chiang Kai-shek, president and commander in chief of the republic, has called today for two divisions of his army from his home province of Chekiang. The first division he has summoned for Nanking, which must be protected at all costs, while his second division has been called for service in Hankow and Wuchang.

In his attempt to make sure of his defense of these two cities, General Chiang will for military assistance from Gen. Feng Hu Hsiang, "the Christian General," in the Province of Honan. Feng however, is threatened with the anti-Nationalist revolts in the neighboring provinces of Shantung and will be unable to send troops to assist General Chiang.


LI TSUNG JEN

Meanwhile Li Tsung Jen, radical communist leader of Hankow, is nursing a dream of his own. With his characteristic thoroughness he is causing the Hankow representatives to the next Nationalist conference to be chosen only among the communists. With the aid of the rising tide of communist reaction, Li expects to snatch the power from Chiang himself. Li seems a stumbling block of considerable proportion to the present Nationalist government, as the spring clash between the forces of General Chiang and General Pai is expected to occur about the middle of this month around Hankow, the home town of Li.

100,000 SNAKES CAUGHT, SOLD IN JAPAN ANNUALLY

The snake, or "the clothed power of the dust" as Ruskin calls it, strikes most people with indescribable fear, but to quite a number of persons in Nippon it is a source of income and livelihood. Each year as many as 100,000 snakes are caught throughout the country by professional snake-finders and then sold for medicinal purposes and as "charms" to bring good-luck and happiness. About half of this amount, however, is bought and distributed in Tokyo by the leading snake dealer in Japan, Mr. Zenkichi Asami, of Asakusa.

ENERGY BUILDER

The species of snake that is now in great demand is the poisonous viper of adder. It is sold as a cure for nervous and physical breakdown and for reviving one's strength after protracted illness. On the whole it may be said that the adder is in demand as a strength and health builder like "Spermatin" and other allied medicines to restore that youthful energy.

Among the ten or so species that are sold in the market, the striped snake or the "shima hebi" is by far the best seller. Its medicinal value is reported to be a cure for consumption, pleurisy and other such diseases.

2000 YR. OLD RELICS DUG BY JAPANESE

"Haniwa" Dummies Unearthed North of Nippon Capital

TOKYO, Mar. 4.—(Special)—A number of "Haniwas," ancient dummies buried in the tombs in the place of human sacrifices to the dead emperors of Nippon some 2000 years ago, have been unearthed at Takasaki, in Gumba prefecture, about 150 miles north of here.

It was the custom of ancient Japan to offer up human sacrifices whenever a ruler passes away. These unfortunate victims of primitive ritual were buried alive with nilly, and ancient record abound with descriptions of how their mournful lamentations and shrieks could be heard from their living graves. An enlightened emperor presently abolished this custom, and he suggested that a dummy be placed in the graves in the place of the human sacrifices. These dummies have been valuable to archeologists, as they reveal the customs and habits of the period. The present finds were buried in an age when Julius Caesar in the Western World was in power in Rome.

THE BLACK SNAKE

The black snake is sold only in small quantities and is used for purposes very similar to those of the striped snake. Besides the species mentioned above, there are four or five others but they find only a very small market at present.

The value of each snake depends on the species and on the quality of each snake as to its length, age and so forth. The adder and the green snake are about the same in price and cost from ¥3 to ¥5 retail. The price is same whether the snake is fresh, dried, or broiled. The striped snake is a little cheaper.

The snake skin is also sold in various forms and ranges from the ¥70 to ¥150 in price, although the very best is sometimes sold for as much as ¥4 to ¥5 each. The skin is used as medicine for toilet and as a symbol of good-luck.

USED FOR RABBIT FOOT

Geishas and spectators on the stock exchange sometimes purchase the skins for their respective purposes, the former so that more and richer customers would come to them, and the latter so that their stocks would soar in value.

The snakes sold in Tokyo and in other centers are mostly caught in the Mikawa district and in the Shiga prefecture, Kansai. Their ages are mostly between three and five years and are from two to three or four

PRESTIGE OF TANAKA IS ON DECLINE

Diet Likely to Pass Only 2 of Dozen Seiyu Bills

TOKYO, Mar. 4.—(Special)—Waning of the Tanaka Government's prestige in the House of Peers is indicated by the number of administration bills which are doomed to rejection before the ten remaining days of the present Parliament session are over.

Out of the dozen major governmental measures introduced in the Diet, only two will be passed, it was indicated from reliable sources.

The Peace Preservation Act, put in force last May through an Imperial edict as an emergency measure, will undoubtedly receive the sanction of the Diet. The budget is also expected to be disposed of in this session.

The major legislations which will fail to pass this session include:

1. Land Tax Transfer Bill, a measure transferring the land revenue from the federal to the local governments.
2. Religious Bill. This act provides for stringent supervision of religious bodies.
3. An act to give the government a monopoly of the nation's fertilizer business.
4. The Land Act, to provide means to accommodate the little farmers financially through loans, in order that breaking up of huge landed estates into smaller farms may be encouraged.
5. Labor Protection Act, which would require employers to provide for protection of their employees who are ill or injured in accidents.
6. The Railway Bill, to provide for extension of the present government lines.
7. The Horse Racing Act, to supervise more strictly this sport in Japan.
