As the Empress prepared for the arrival of her fourth child, preparations both official and unofficial were made in confident hopes that it will be a prince and heir apparent to the throne. The prince eventually would succeed his father, the Emperor, as 15th emperor in the unbroken line descended from Jimmu Tenno, the first Emperor of Japan.
