



Former Pastor Joins Agitation Against Religion

OFFICERS of the Northern California Young People's Christian conference are reported to be worried over the slowness with which registrations are coming in.

At about the same date, the Buddhist young people of the Bay District will also be holding a conference. We wish them all success.

MANY first generation people, and many second generation youngsters too, will scoff at the activities of these religious groups.

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 2.—A group of Japanese promoting an anti-church movement here are expected to raise a great uproar when they hold a public gathering this Saturday evening, October 3, at the Kita Nogaku hall on San Pedro street.

Hakomori, according to the local churchmen, created a disturbance at a gospel meeting of Toyohiko Kagawa held recently under the sponsorship of the Japanese Church Federation of Southern California.

The gathering is creating a great sensation here with the announcement that Nobara Sekiguchi will be included among the five speakers who will appear before the audience to appeal for public sympathy and justice.

JAPAN PROVOKED BEYOND ENDURANCE, SAYS MANCHURIAN RAILWAY OFFICIAL

NEW YORK, Oct. 1.—This present clash between the Japanese and the Chinese army in Manchuria is not at all an expected incident. In fact it is an inevitable result of the numerous anti-Japanese incidents which have been taking place in Manchuria since this last spring.

"It would be unjust for other parties to refer to the Kellogg Pact or to appeal to the League of Nations without knowing in full the real nature of the Chinese attitude toward Japan, nor the position of Japan in Manchuria."

The general sentiment of the Chinese has been calculated to give the Japanese from Manchuria. The unofficial press has been demanding that the Japanese government withdraw from Manchuria.

"The Japanese public, on the other hand, is strongly insisting that Japan should remain firm in Manchuria. They feel that since Japan has 10,000 people and \$200,000,000 in Manchuria Japanese people are prone to be aroused to bitter feeling toward China on small provocation."

JAPAN PLANS BIG SLASH IN BUDGET

Army, Navy to Suffer Largest Cut in Expense

TOKYO, Oct. 2.—Junnosuke Inouye, Minister of Finance, today submitted to the cabinet the official estimate for next year's budget. The estimate calls for a total governmental expenditure of ¥1,330,000,000 a reduction of ¥120,000,000 over last year's figure.

The submission of the estimates was delayed this year on account of the extra work required in planning for a program of general rearmament. Estimates are usually submitted in June.

CHINA FILES NEW PROTEST

TOKYO, Oct. 2.—Chiang Tso-ping, the new Chinese minister to Japan, filed another note of protest with the Japanese Foreign Office today. The new note demanded that Japanese troops be withdrawn from Manchuria so that Chinese forces might have complete freedom of movement to crush the incipient independence movement in Manchuria.
