RUSS SEEKS AMITY PACT WITH JAPAN

Tokyo Has no Design On Russia Says Inukai

TOKYO, Jan. 16.—Special to The Japanese American News—Premier Inukai today told the Soviet ambassador here that Japan harbors not an iota of thought for aggression into Russian territory, and that therefore such a pact as suggested by U. S. S. R. for declaration of non-aggression between the two countries would be unnecessary.

TOKYO, Jan. 16 (U.P.)—A Soviet proposal for a Russo-Japanese non-aggression pact was confirmed today by the Japanese government.

The proposal was made by Maxim Litvinoff, Soviet commissar for foreign affairs, to Japanese Foreign Minister Kenkichi Yoshizawa when the latter was in Moscow enroute from Paris to Tokyo.

[Special to Japanese American News] LOS ANGELES, Jan. 16.—Dr. Kawai Kawai member of the historical department of the Stanford university, spoke on the subject of the Manchurian dispute to a large audience at Royce hall of the University of California at Los Angeles, Wednesday evening.

Kawai declared that since there is no state of war existing between Japan and China, there can be no violation of the Kellogg-Briand anti-war pact.

'OPEN DOOR' IS OBSERVED AVERS NOTE

Japan Supports U. S. Policy in New Note

TOKYO, Jan. 16.—Foreign Minister Kenkichi Yoshizawa replied today to Secretary of State Stimson's note invoking the nine power pact in the Manchurian conflict by declaring that the open door policy will be maintained in Manchuria.

The Japanese note said in part: "As regards the question which your excellency specifically mentions the policy of the so-called open door, the Japanese government has so often been stated, regard that policy as a cardinal feature of the policies of the Far East and only regret that its effectiveness is so seriously diminished by the unsettled conditions which prevail throughout China.

"In so far as they can secure it, the policy of the open door will always be maintained in Manchuria as in China proper.

The note expressed appreciation of American support of Japanese efforts to uphold the nine power pact and the Kellogg treaty, and noted that America will not admit legality of matters impairing treaty rights obtained contrary to the Kellogg pact.

Conditions in China Cited

It also said: "The present unsettled and distracted state of China is not what was in contemplation of the contracting parties at the time of the treaty of Washington. It was certainly unsatisfactory then, but did not display that disunion and antagonisms which it does today. This cannot affect the binding character of the stipulation of treaties, but may materially modify their application since they must necessarily be applied with reference to facts as they exist."

Nichiren Temple in S.F. Organizes New Language Institute

Establishment of a Japanese language school under the management of Isen Kanno, well known Japanese poet, was announced by officials Friday of the Nichiren temple at 2016 Pine street.

The board of faculty will be led by Nitto Isahida, priest of the temple.

Nichiren is one of the many denominations of Buddhism. It was originally founded by Saint Nichiren about the time of the attempted Mongol invasion of Japan.
