FUJITA WINS DECISION IN COURT CASE

Sonoma County Gives Affirmation To Japanese

The right of a foreign born Japanese subject to hold land in trust in California for his children who are citizens of the United States was affirmed in a decision handed down Tuesday by the State supreme court.

The opinion upholds a decision of the Sonoma county superior court under which T. Fujita and his four native born children will retain ownership of a poultry farm in that county.

The action was brought by the district attorney who sought to oust the Fujita family and cause their holdings to escheat to the state under the alien land law.

It was charged that the property was purchased through fraud and that a trusteeship in favor of the children was merely a mask for the alien father's actual ownership.

The court held that there was no evidence of fraudulent ownership and that Fujita has filed annual reports of his accounts as trustee and complied with filing requirements of the law.

BOOK AUTHOR COMING SOON

Writes Novel, Mother, Nationally Known Lecturer

Yusuke Tsurumi, internationally known lecturer and former member of the Imperial Japanese Diet, will give a series of three lectures before Japanese audiences in Northern California under the auspices of the Japanese American News.

The brilliant and versatile speaker, who is also a novelist of some distinction, will speak in San Francisco, probably at the Reformed church, on Mar. 7. He will speak in Fresno on Mar. 8, and in Oakland on Mar. 9.

He will speak on the subject of the Sino-Japanese dispute in both Manchuria and Shanghai. Having interviewed China just prior to the outbreak of hostilities last fall, Tsurumi will present a graphic picture to his audience of the realities in the political and economic life of the Celestial Kingdom.

Among the personalities he interviewed are Gen. Chiang Kai-shek, commander in chief of the Chinese army; Gen. Chang Hsiung, deposed war lord of Manchuria; and Dr. Wellington Koo, Chinese foreign minister.

Tsurumi is the author of "Mother," a recent novel translated into English and now on sale in the leading book stores of the United States.

CHINESE ARE LEAVING FOR SAFETY ZONE

Withdrawing To Line Set By Nippon Ultimatum

By THE UNITED PRESS SHANGHAI, Mar. 2.—Chinese defense troops evacuated their fortifications around Shanghai under a withering fire from the Japanese today and re-established positions miles to the rear for another dogged stand.

Chinese commanders of the 19th route army, principal defense unit, paraphrased Commander Perry's "we have not as yet begun to fight," as troops completed their orderly retreat to second defense lines.

The evacuation began shortly before expiration of a Japanese ultimatum threatening to blow up the main Shanghai railway line.

Within a few hours the Chinese troops were solidly behind fortifications 20 kilometers away, just outside a zone around the International Settlement which the Japanese had demanded they evacuate.

Japanese Shell Zone The Wusong and Kiangwan area scene of heavy bombardments and bitter fighting, were completely evacuated at 1 p. m. Shanghai time, 9 a. m. Tuesday Pacific time.

The Japanese began raining heavy artillery fire into the evacuated positions at Chapei at 2 p. m. fearing they might advance into a trap or mined ground.

The Japanese announced the capture of Tazang, just before the Chinese evacuation order became known.

Tazang is four miles west of Ki-angwan.
