LOS ANGELES, Apr. 10—Tatsu-  
ichi Eguchi was released on a writ  
of habeas corpus issued by United  
States District Judge Cosgrave yes-  
terday when testimony was fur-  
nished that United States immigra-  
tion officers had used unwar-  
ranted means in his arrest.

by the immigration officers in 1929  
and held for several days without
