800,000 WILL MIGRATE TO NEW NATION

Gigantic Emigration Project Planned By Japanese

TOKYO, May 7.—The first batch of some 3000 Japanese, made up of 640 families, of a total of 800,000 emigrants to carry out the Overseas Ministry's 12 year plan, will be sent to Manchuria during 1932-33.

The appropriation of 3,065,000 yen which is now being demanded by the ministry for inclusion in the additional budget for 1932-33 for the Manchurian emigration plan, comprises 1,200,000 yen, fund for purchasing land and 1,833,000 yen loans subsidies and other expenses for the first group of 3000 emigrants.
