NANBU, ODA ARE JAPAN'S CHIEF OLYMPIC THREATS

(Special to Japanese American News) LOS ANGELES, July 13—In Chubu Nanbu and Mikio Oda, Japan has two mighty sweet athletes, according to the track experts who have watched these two premier track men in their preliminary workouts. Nanbu is the world's record holder with a broad jump mark of over 26 feet while Oda, Japan Olympic track captain, holds the hop, step and jump title which he won at Amsterdam in 1928 as well as the world's record which he made in 1931 with a 15.83 meter performance. U. S. Is Convinced American track coaches had been inclined to scoff at these two Japanese and look with skepticism at the manner in which the mark were measured in Nippon but after seeing them in action even the most skeptical have become convinced. Oda has not been able to do much in his favorite event due to a leg injury but evidently his leg injury does not bother him much for he high jumped over 6 feet just a couple of days ago. It is almost a cinch that Oda will repeat as the Olympic champion. American track critics look upon Nanbu to furnish the most competition to their broad jumping hopes. If Nanbu can hit his stride, he will win his first Olympic title, for none of the U. S. jumpers have done 26 feet. But the sad part of it, is that Nanbu has not done better than 25 feet in competition this year. May Round Into Form However, since there is yet about 3 weeks remaining before the opening of the games and a lot of things can happen. Hence, it is entirely within reason that these two Japanese will round into shape and may show their stuff in a convincing style. Besides being able to better than 6 feet in the high jump, Oda can broad jump with the best performers without being exhausted of himself, having a record of 1.52 meters, which is in the neighborhood of 25 feet. In addition, he is a pole vaulter of no mean ability. Nanbu, like his captain, is a versatile man. He is a hop, step and jump expert, being excelled perhaps by Oda only if he settled down and trained for the event. When it comes to sprinting Nanbu will not take much dust from the best in field for his time in the 100 meters is under 11 seconds. May Sprint In Games In fact, Nanbu has been showing so much speed in the sprints that the Japan coaches have been seriously thinking of using him in relay races at the Olympics. At the time that Nanbu and Oda were team mates on the Waseda track squad, these two often duelled it out for points in the broad jump, but after a few of these trials, the two stars decided to refrain from competing against each other. Hence, Nanbu specialized in the broad jump and Oda took the hop, step, and jump.
